<u>Introduction</u>	- Questions were used effectively to introduce the session - I liked the way you used a quote for reinforcing the topic. - Use of personal experiences and patient examples
<u>Blackboard Preparation and Use</u>	- Good, clearly legible. Your printing was more legible than the writing. Colour? Perhaps it might be possible to use coloured chalk to add attraction and probably more importantly differentiate sections of your lecture model describing personality. - Liked the build up of your model
<u>Teaching Points</u>	- Excellent teaching techniques (questions) - Voice clear and audible, use of silence effective. Perhaps June you could practice "speeding" up your statements. I appreciate this is easier said than done - When asking the students questions allow a little more time for them to "reflect" on what you ask. e.g. Your question on social factors I felt needed a little more time for the students to reflect. - The participation of the students really "warmed" as the session proceeded. When discussion is taking place why not move from the "front" of the lectern and "join" the group so to speak. - This could be achieved by sitting down with the group. - Rapport with student nurses was excellent.
<u>Work Tasks</u>	- Good to see the students being involved in follow up assignment work as part of the session. - Would it not have been better June to ask for a quick summary back from each subgroup on what they read and understood (hopefully)
<u>Teaching Points Cont'd</u>	- Glad to see you "join" the group from behind your lectern. - Use of videotape recording.
<u>Analysis</u>	- Summary of tape good. Perhaps they could have spent more time analysing.
